The Ride4Life Ministries Mission:

Ride4Life Ministries (“R4L”) brings the Gospel message of Hope through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ as it seeks to change the destiny of individuals while transforming their communities. R4L, which operates a motorcycle stunt team, shares the good news of the Gospel with otherwise unreached individuals of all ethnicities in non-traditional marketplace venues such as prisons, community festivals, motorsports events, outreach events, schools and orphanages. In addition to the general public and youth of all ages, these individuals are often troubled or “at-risk” including prisoners and others who are substance-addicted (primarily alcohol and/or drugs).

R4L has forged strategic relationships with collaborating organizations that share a vision for accomplishing this mission which encompasses all seven cultural “mountains”-

Why Ride4Life

- Audit of Federal BOP Management and Oversight of its Chaplaincy Services Program (Department of Justice)
 - “As of March 2020, approx. 70% of the BOP’s inmate population officially identified with a faith group.”

In 2023, the U.S. prison population was 1,230,100. Approximately 70% of the Bureau of Prison's inmate population officially identified with a faith group.

Ride4Life reaches the prison population in the most unique way by offering a Yard Party (motorcycle stunt show), Trench Warfare Program, and a Fellowship Program.

By bringing a message of Hope into the prisons, we strengthen the connection with Jesus Christ which fosters transformation within the community as inmates reintegrate.

Yard Party Program Overview

Program:

- Available to anyone in the population with access to the yard
- One day event
 - Two hour program in the yard
 - Includes pre show music
 - Motorcycle stunt show
 - Post show messages, Bible distribution, and Trench Warfare Program signup

Purpose:

- Bring a gospel message of Hope through a personal relationship with Jesus Christ by utilizing a motorcycle stunt team and post show message of redemption

Philosophy:

- Everyone is reachable, it is never too late

Pastors:

- Bible distribution
- Discipleship sign up
- Possible Baptism of inmates if applicable

Trench Warfare Discipleship Program

Program:

- Registration dependent and class size varies based on meeting room limitations
- Seven-week program
 - Second phase following Yard Party Discipleship Program sign ups
 - One lesson per week in large group setting
- Each lesson covers:
 - Core values based on Biblical principals
 - New Testament parables
 - Jesus Christ miracles and how this relates to our life
 - Question and Answer session
 - Optional Homework that allows continued engagement
- Outcome measurement and analytics

Purpose:

- Minister to adults and young adults that have had no guidance or parenting leading to a lack of moral compass that has resulted in time behind bars and take “hopeless” individuals from the trenches in life into the loving arms of Jesus Christ.

Philosophy:

- There is no time to waste!

R4L Fellowship Program Overview

Program:

- Registration dependent and class size varies based on meeting room limitations
- Bi-weekly service
 - 1-2 hour service
- Services include:
 - Pre and Post Fellowship time
 - Pastoral Message
 - Scripture Reading
 - Prayer time
 - Outcome tracking

Purpose:

- Sustainment strategy to allow continued engagement from discipleship members and an open invitation to other inmates who have not attended the discipleship program.

Philosophy:

- Worship fosters a healthy relationship with Jesus Christ

Prison Program Volunteers

"I was at church when I found out about the need for extra hands for the Ride4Life event at Belmont Corrections. My wife actually pushed me to do it because I've been reluctant to step up and volunteer for anything outside of my normal church attendance. I signed up mainly because of her. I've never been to prison and didn't really have any interest in going to the place.

The morning of the event, I was frantic to not be late and couldn't find my car keys at the last minute, so it was a very stressful morning and I almost didn't go out of frustration. I ended up persevering and making it on time. It was almost a 2-hour drive going down there, and most of the drive I was questioning why I was even going when I didn't feel I had anything to offer them other than being a body. I say all of this because most of the time leading up to watching all those men surround us, I doubted the purpose of us even being there. I doubted that watching men ride wheelies in a prison yard would actually make a difference to a bunch of convicts. As I stood on the side of the trailer after the stunt team performed, with my back to the inmates, listening to Scott give his testimony, I did not realize how close they were behind me until I heard Scott ask them if anyone wanted to receive Jesus into their lives, and to please take a step forward. I heard the whole prison yard full of men literally take a step forward, and those men were now standing beside me.

I just wanted to describe this experience this way because months later, the sound of all of those footsteps still echoed in my mind. I doubted anyone really wanted to receive Jesus that day until I saw it happen. Describing this experience to my 20-year-old still made me emotional a month later. It was one of the most powerful things I have ever witnessed in my life, and I am thankful I persevered that morning to go help because I needed to experience that myself. I believe in this ministry and what it stands for because of my experience. I can only pray that those men's lives are changed forever because of Ride4Life, and that they really are making a lasting difference to those men because it is needed in this broken world, and we need ministries like Scott's to reach them all!"

I have been blessed to be an active participant in 3 ride for life prison event's or yard parties as Scott likes to affectionately call them. Going into a prison is not an easy thing to do. It takes courage and the love of Jesus to see past all of the hurt and brokenness of the individuals you encounter. This includes the staff members, guards, Inmates and even the warden's themselves.

Ride 4 life and the motorcycle ministry has a niche that is attractive to a lot of men, stunt riding on bikes. Although this can be the initial draw for a lot of them, I have come to learn that it is more than that. Scott and his team do ride the bikes amazingly well, however they do an even better job of conveying the message to the inmates that Jesus does love them and forgives them for all that they have done. The basic message is we are all the same at the foot of the cross. It is like Jesus said in the book of Matthew Chapter 11 verse 28. Come to me, all of you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest.

I have had the experience of going into jails before and have seen men commit their lives to Christ before. The day we visited Lake Erie correctional this summer was a special day I will never forget. It was raining and there was some concern that the bikes could not be ridden. God Cleared up the skies just enough with a light mist that the show did go on. That day I witnessed 57 men being baptized and publicly declaring that they are committed to follow Jesus. This was a miracle of God in itself. The testimonies from Scott and others about the life changing power of the Gospel and the healing that can and does take place moved the inmates that day. The atmosphere is definitely one where men can be willing to accept Jesus, However Ride 4 life with the Stunt Bike Show and the testimonies of Men who have been incarcerated and have turned it around are so very powerful. Follow all of this up with a solid discipleship program and you have a formula that can transform lives. This is a ministry that is having an impact for the Kingdom. I would urge you if you have a heart for visiting inmates to go along on an event and see for yourselves.
